- Jacksonville North Pulaski will be a school district of choice that fosters student achievement and success

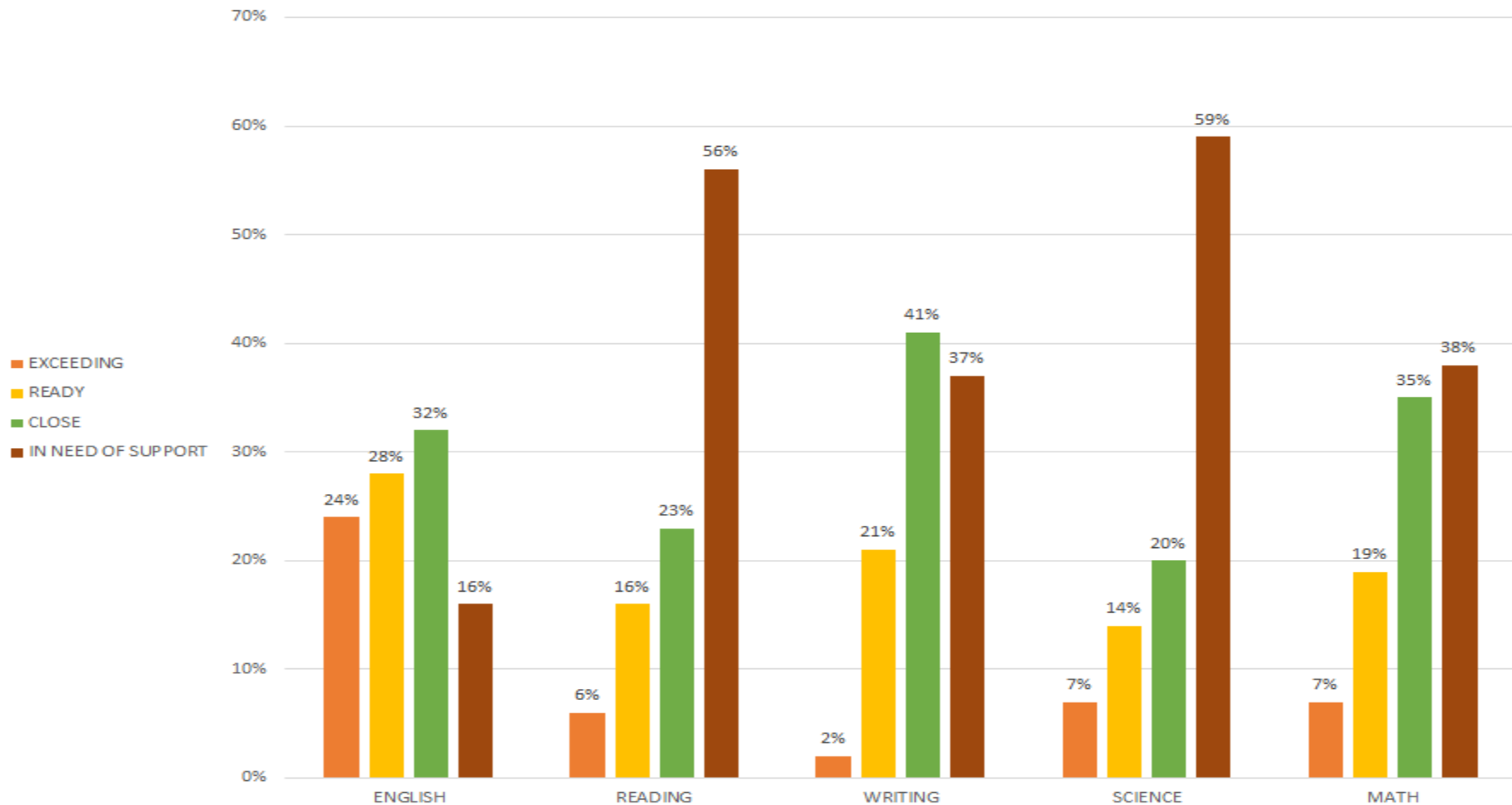
OUR MISSION:
